INVENTION ASSIGNMENT & SECRECY AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this Eight day of November, 2002

 ("Employee")

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Visionwall is engaged in the business of manufacturing, using, installing and marketing high insulation technology windows and doors (the "Product"); and Employee is or will be employed and compensated by Visionwall and Visionwall desires to protect its inventions, trade secrets and confidential information, and in the course of Employee's work for Visionwall, Employee has or may have access to inventions, trade secrets or confidential information belonging to Visionwall;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the recitals above, mutual covenants, promises and undertakings herein, the parties agree as follows:

1.0 DEFINITIONS

The following definitions shall apply to this Agreement:

1.1 "Invention" includes any design, process, formula or any idea, discovered, conceived, developed, written or produced, or any modification or improvements to them.

1.2 "Trade Secrets" includes all proprietary information belonging to Visionwall including documents, samples, drawings, photographs, designs, plans, flow charts, proposals, marketing and sales plans, financial information, costs, pricing information, processes, equipment, manuals, reports, computer programs, technical information, technical expertise, technical specifications, research results, patents, copyrights and all concepts or ideas in any way related to the business of Visionwall that have not previously been publicly released.

1.3 "Confidential Information" includes all "Trade Secrets", as well as any handwritten manuals, account information, customer records, formulas, client lists, leads, procedures, and all other information that has been marked confidential or is known to be proprietary, whether it has copyright notice or a claim to copyright thereon.

2.0 SECRECY

2.1 In connection with Employee's activities on behalf of Visionwall, Employee has had access, or may in the future have access, to certain confidential information, inventions or trade secrets of Visionwall. Employee recognizes the proprietary and sensitive nature of such and agrees to abide by all Visionwall rules and procedures designed to protect its proprietary information in strict confidence during his/her employment by Visionwall and as long thereafter as such information is confidential or proprietary to Visionwall. Employee agrees that he/she will not use, disclose, or in any other way use or disseminate such information except as authorized in writing by duly authorized representatives of Visionwall.

2.2 Employee further agrees to disclose promptly in writing to the officials designated by Visionwall any inventions or confidential information before any conceive, develop or make in carrying out his/her assignments for Visionwall whether he/she considers them patentable or copyrightable or not, and developed alone or with others.

3.0 ASSIGNMENT AND OWNERSHIP

3.1 Employee agrees to assign, and hereby does assign, to Visionwall all interest in all confidential information, trade secrets, and inventions, whether copyrightable or patentable or not, made or conceived by Employee, solely or jointly for Visionwall, except for any invention for which no equipment, supplies, facility or confidential information of Visionwall was used and which was developed entirely on the Employee's own time, and (a) which does not relate to (1) the business of Visionwall or (2) Visionwall's actual or demonstrably anticipated research or development, or (b) which does not result from any work performed by the Employee for Visionwall. All confidential information, trade secrets and inventions assigned herein and hereinafter referred to as "Assigned Inventions".

3.2 Employee agrees to disclose all Assigned Inventions in writing to Visionwall, to assist Visionwall in preparing patent or copyright applications for Assigned Inventions, and to execute said applications and all other documents required to obtain patents or copyrights for these Assigned Inventions and to vest title therein in Visionwall, at Visionwall's expense, but for no additional consideration to Employee. In the event that Visionwall requires assistance under this paragraph after termination of employment, Employee agrees to provide such assistance.

2.3 On termination of employment, Employee agrees to return to Visionwall all copies of documents or information containing trade secrets, inventions or confidential information of Visionwall and all other confidential or proprietary work in his/her possession or control or generated within the scope of employment. Employee agrees not to deliver, reproduce, or in any way allow such documents or things to be delivered or used by any third parties without specific direction or consent of a duly authorized representative of Visionwall. During or after termination of employment, Employee will not publish, release, relate, or otherwise make available to any third parties any information describing Visionwall inventions, confidential information or trade secrets without prior specific written authorization of Visionwall.

4.0 REPRESENTATIONS

4.1 Employee hereby certifies that he/she has no continuing obligations with respect to assignment of inventions, trade secrets or confidential information to any previous employer or other person nor does he/she claim any previous unpatented or non-published inventions or expressions, respectively, within the scope of this Agreement.

5.0 BREACH OR THREATENED BREACH

5.1 Employee acknowledges that Visionwall and any person, corporation, partnership or other entity affiliated with Visionwall will suffer immediate and irreparable harm as a result of any violation, breach, or threatened breach of this Agreement by Employee, and that Visionwall shall be entitled and Employee hereby consents to the issuance in any court of competent jurisdiction, with or without notice, and in addition to any other remedy, including damages, which may be available at law or in equity, to temporary, interim and permanent orders and injunctions, without bond, restraining and enjoining such breach or violation by Employee and any other person, corporation, partnership or other entity including their officers, directors, shareholders, employees, servants or agents who may be acting in concert with Employee or to whom such Confidential Information may be or may have been disclosed.

6.0 GENERAL

6.1 Should any term or provision of this Agreement be found to be invalid or unenforceable, such findings shall in no way affect the validity or enforceability of the other terms and conditions hereof. Such other terms and conditions shall be valid and enforceable, as if the invalid and unenforceable term, condition, or provision was never a part hereof.

6.2 The failure at any time or from time to time to require strict performance by any party or any of the provisions, covenants, representations, terms and conditions contained in this Agreement or any other agreement, document or instrument hereafter executed by the parties, shall not waive, effect or diminish any right of any other party thereafter to demand strict compliance and performance therewith. No waiver shall be deemed by reason of any act or knowledge of any party to be an act, but waiver shall be accomplished only by an instrument in writing signed by the party to be determined by such waiver and delivered to the other party.

6.3 The subject headings of this Agreement are included for the purpose of convenience only and shall not affect the construction or interpretation of any provision hereof.

6.4 Employee acknowledges that he/she has read this Agreement, understands it, and agrees to be bound by its terms. The parties further agree that this Agreement constitutes the entire and exclusive agreement between the parties pertaining to the subject matter contained in it, and supersedes all prior or contemporaneous agreements, oral or written, conditions, representations, warranties, proposals and understandings of the parties pertaining to such subject matter. The parties further agree that this Agreement may not, in any way, be explained or supplemented by a prior or existing course of dealing between the parties, by any usage or trade or custom or by any prior performance between the parties. No supplement, modification or amendment of the Agreement shall be binding unless executed in writing by all the parties herein.

6.5 The provisions of this Agreement survive to the benefit of and are binding on the heirs, personal representative, successors and assigns of Employee and the successors and assigns of Visionwall.
