The invention relates to an absorbent product (1), the absorbent product (1) comprising a liquid-permeable top layer (2), a liquid-impermeable bottom layer (4) and an absorbent core (3) arranged between the top layer (2) and the bottom layer (4). The absorbent product (1) has a head product portion (b1), an intermediate product portion (b2) and a rear product portion (b3) extending in a longitudinal direction of the absorbent product (1). The absorbent product (1) has an outer contour (100) having a shape resembling an hourglass, wherein the intermediate product portion (b2) comprises an area with a smaller width than any area in the head product portion (b1) and rear product portion (b3), respectively, and wherein the core (3) extends in the longitudinal direction and transverse direction of the absorbent product (1) and has an outer contour (300) that is asymmetrical with the outer contour (100) of the absorbent product (1).

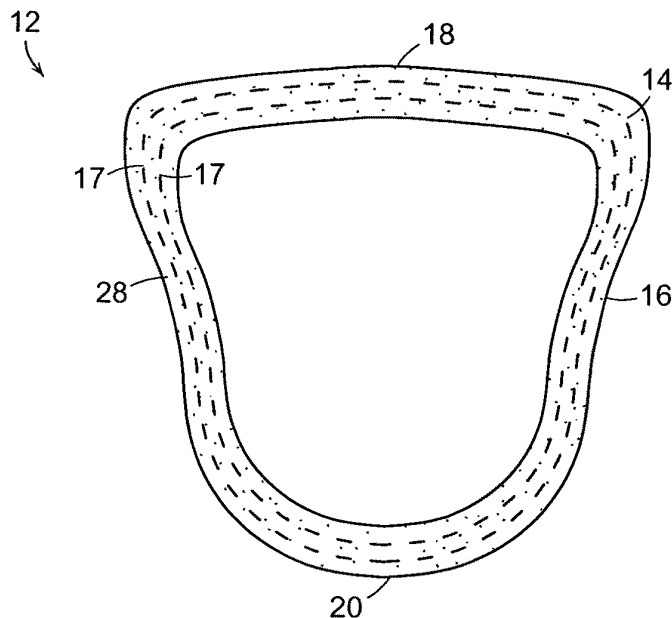

An undergarment comprises a strapless, coreless web sized and configured between an anterior end and a posterior end to cover, in use, at least the vulva of an adult female wearer. The undergarment is pre-adherent to the wearer, e.g., having pre-applied adhesive or pre-applied suction material on the body side of the web, suitable for contact with human skin and sufficiently adherent to removably hold the undergarment in place during use. In another aspect, a feminine undergarment comprises such pre-adherent strapless, coreless web with a removable protective cover over at least the adhesive. In another aspect, a package of feminine undergarments comprises outer packaging containing at least multiple of such feminine undergarments and optionally inner packaging for each of the undergarments individually.

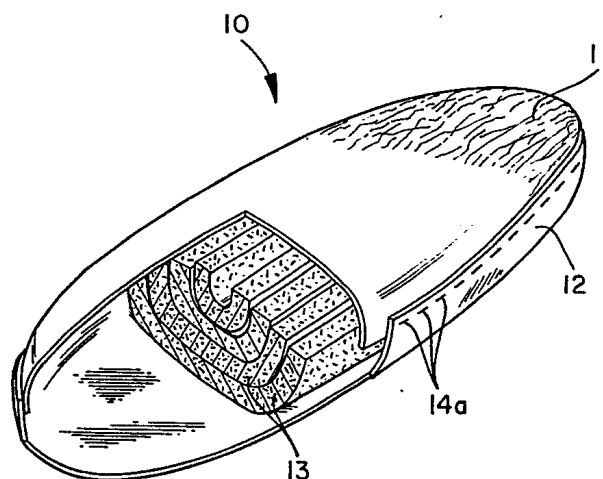

The invention relates to an absorbent product with a longitudinal direction and a transverse direction, two side edges (109, 110) extending essentially in the longitudinal direction, a front portion (114), a rear portion (115), a first surface and a second surface, and an absorption body (105) arranged between the first surface and the second surface. The absorbent product is essentially triangular in shape, the front portion (114) being wider than the rear portion (115). The absorption body (105) also has a main absorption part (106) which is shaped and positioned in such a manner in the plane of the product that at least 85 % of the total absorption capacity of the product is in the front three quarters of the length of the product and at least 70 % of the absorption capacity is found in the front half of the product.

The present invention relates to an absorbent article, especially an incontinence pad, having a length and a width extension, said length being greater than said width, and comprising absorbent core material, wherein the outer longitudinal edges of said absorbent material form three convex lobes (2, 3, 4), wherein a pair of folding lines (5) extend between the longitudinal ends of the middle one (3) of said three lobes (2, 3, 4), so as to divide the absorbent core material into a central portion (6) and a pair of longitudinal side portions (7), such that, when the article (1) is in use, the folding lines (5) are generally positioned so as to extend along the crotch area of the user, starting from the gracilis tendons and ending in the region of the perineum, whereby the side portions (7) may extend from the central portion (6) towards the user so as to form an arc shape as seen in a transversal direction of the article (1).

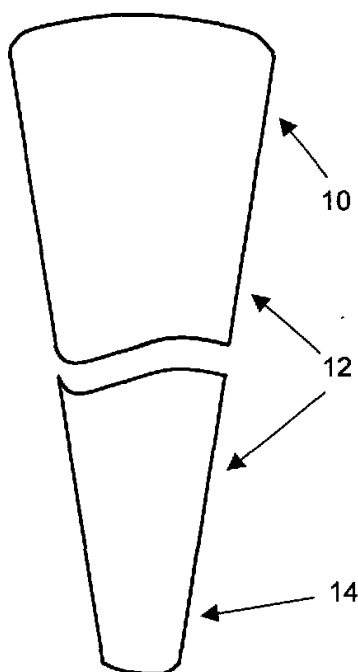

This absorbent element contains an absorbent material (32) which remains free-flowing even after contact with a liquid. The invention also relates to an absorbent item which has a liquid-impermeable layer which faces away from the body when the item is in use and an absorbent element which is surrounded by a liquid-permeable layer, said absorbent element containing a material which remains free-flowing and absorbent even after contact with a liquid. The absorbent element is joined to the liquid-impermeable layer in a central area of said layer.

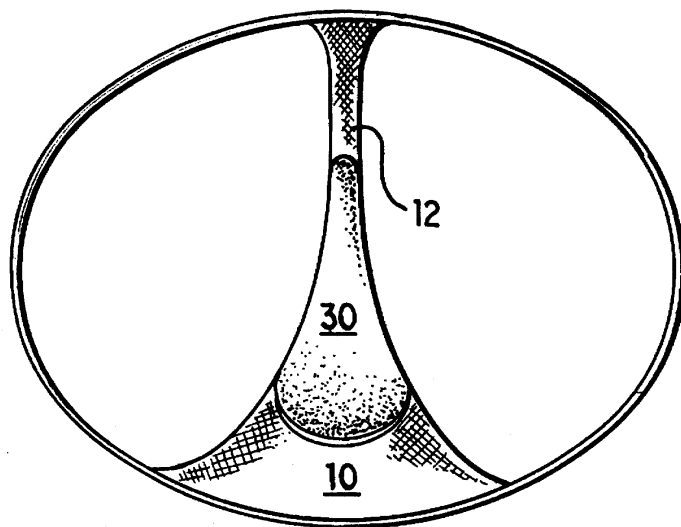

The present invention relates to an absorbent article (1) having front, crotch and rear portions (2, 3, 4) and an absorbent core (6) of unitary construction. The core has a first region (12) comprising two legs (15, 16) extending in the longitudinal direction of the article over at least parts of the crotch portion towards endings (17,18) in the rear portion. A maximum distance ($a_{₁}$) between facing sides (19, 20) of the legs in the transverse direction is, in the crotch portion, located at a position in the longitudinal direction corresponding to a crotch point (21). Furthermore, the facing sides of the legs converge backwards such that a distance (a_x) between them is reduced from the maximum distance ($a_{₁}$) to a minimum distance (82) in the rear portion. In addition, the core comprises a second region (24) surrounding the first region and the average density of the core is lower in the second region than in the first region.

The present invention relates to an absorbent article (10) having front (12), crotch (14) and rear (16) portions. A minimum distance a_l between said first and second lower thickness regions (28;30) in the transverse direction is located at least in the transition (32) between the crotch portion (14) and the front portion (12). The article provides good, secure fit and high comfort to the wearer.

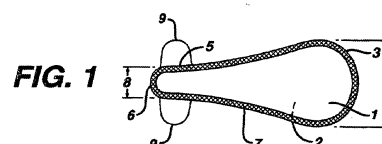

Improved method and apparatus for forming absorbent products and the improved absorbent products formed thereby are disclosed. In a first embodiment of the present invention, a rotary die (100) is used to cut ellipsoidal and hyperbolic-shaped portions (52, 54) from a single sheet of material (50) and these shapes are overlaid to form an absorbent structure. 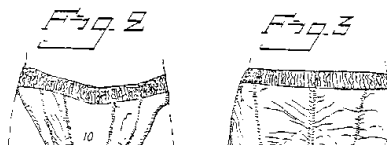
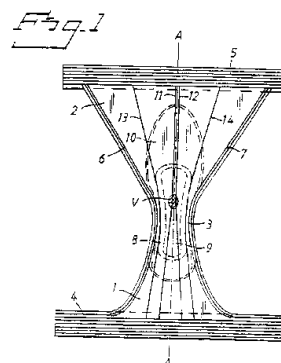

The present invention relates to a sanitary napkin or like absorbent article, such as a sanitary pantie or incontinence guard, comprising an absorbent body (8) which is enclosed between a fluid-permeable (15) and a fluid-impermeable casing sheet (17). According to the invention, the absorbent body (8) comprises a primary absorbent body (9) having the capacity to absorb all fluid discharged from a user over an intended article use period, and a secondary absorbent body (10) whose area is at least 50 % larger than the area
