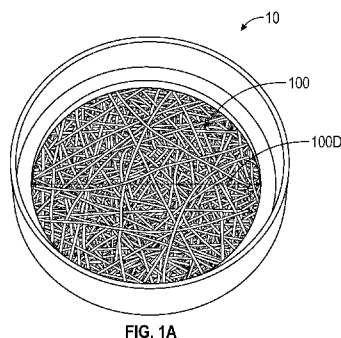

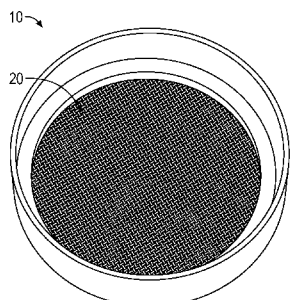

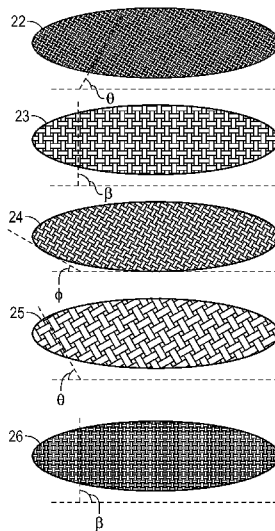

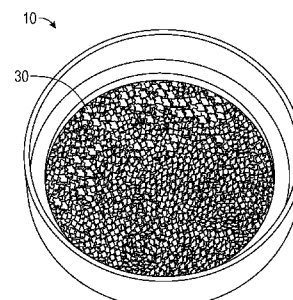

(57) Abstract: A drug pad is operable to retain a drug. The drug pad includes a plurality of sintered metal fibers forming a plurality of pores, and a drug retained on the plurality of sintered metal fibers. The plurality of pores define a porosity of the drug pad.

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
